

Aegis Donates to Warrior Canine Connection

Aegis Metal Framing donated the truss material and All-Span, Inc., a certified Aegis system fabricator, donated the labor and delivery of a set of roof trusses to the Warrior Canine Connection Healing Quarters in Germantown, MD for the new **WCC Welcome Center**. Warrior Canine Connection is a pioneering organization that utilizes clinically based Canine Connection Therapy to help wounded warriors reconnect with life, their families, their communities and each other. WCC is a nationally recognized organization that was founded in 2011, integrated into the recovery and retraining programs at Walter Reed Medical Center, Fort Belvoir and the Palo Alto VA Healthcare System. Since the inception, WCC has trained and placed assistance dogs and provided support for 3,000 Warriors.

On June 17, 2016 Aegis and All-Span volunteers met WCC volunteers at the site of an iconic dairy farm that is being transformed into a facility that will help support WCC's growth. They spent the better part of 2 days constructing the cold-formed steel walls and installing the Ultra-Span trusses for the first building of the large project.

The final compound, shown here, will be home to breeding and training of thousands of training dogs and the warriors that train them for fellow warriors.
